

Wilbert Trail

Location: 4128 South Smugglers Cove Road, Freeland. Trail is located within South Whidbey State Park.

Parking: Ample parking is available including a pull-out at the trail's northern entrance with room for about 4 cars

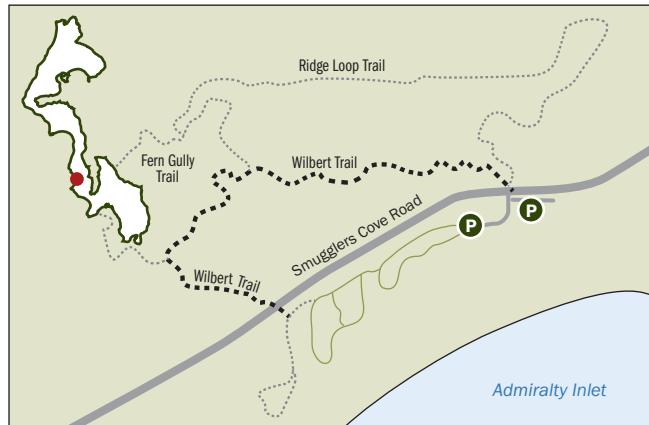
Fees: Discovery Pass required

Difficulty: Moderate

Trail length: 0.8 miles one way

Walk among the giants in the old-growth forest at South Whidbey State Park. This area is the last remnant of old-growth forest at the south end of Whidbey Island and features numerous massive trees that are hundreds of years old. About 250 feet from the second trailhead is a short trail leading to a 500-year-old Cedar Tree. Several small

streams cut across the trail creating gullies which can make the trail more difficult. Numerous interpretive signs offer good information. To add some variety, return through what once was the park's campgrounds. Trails in the former campground are paved and flat.
